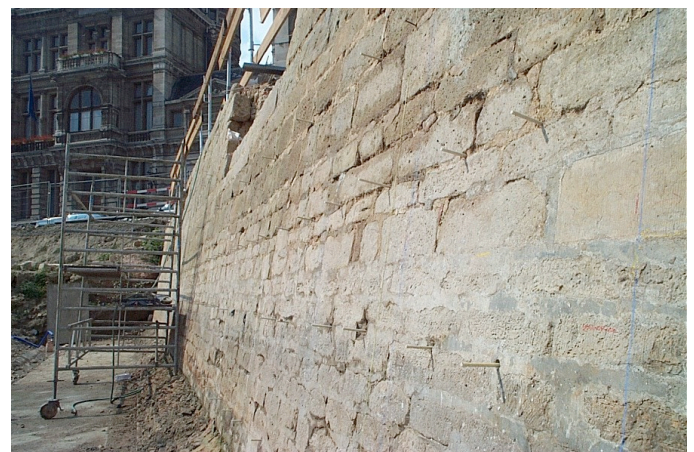

NON FERROUS REINFORCEMENT

GFRP anchors for Spanish Fortress walls in Antwerp

During excavation for the renovation of the old ring road of Antwerp, called “de Leien”, archeologists found remains of a Spanish Fortress that was part of the city walls around Antwerp about 450 years ago. These ancient masonry walls needed to be removed and would be installed in the underground parking of the National Bank, for the general public to enjoy. To move these 16th century masonry walls they needed to be stabilised and then cut into pieces, so these blocks could be transported. About 3000 meter of Aslan GFRP rebars were grouted into the masonry walls to stabilise the Spanish brick walls
